Solution

3720 Dillon Street is an old commercial office building that has recently been renovated by the Association of Maryland Pilots. As part of the renovation, a Controlsoft card access system was installed on certain doors to restrict access and ensure that only pilots have access to certain areas.

Controlsoft iNet door controllers have been used in conjunction with HID iCLASS SE Mobile readers. These are all controlled using the Controlsoft Identity Access software which makes for a simple yet effective access

control system. As well as using keyfobs, the pilots have an HID Mobile credential on their phone. The HID Mobile credentials are issued from Identity Access and sent to the users smartphone.



HID Mobile credentials are useful if the pilots have left their keys at home because they always have their phone. The mobile credential acts just like a virtual keyfob. Some pilots have an Apple watch and the mobile credential also works on that.
